### Adding PATHS in Google Earth

1. Add paths between placemarkers or to indicate a route on the globe
2. Click the PATH icon in toolbar
3. The popup window opens; give the path a name
4. With the window still open, click on the map; do not hold and drag the mouse
5. Click on another spot on the map/globe
6. You will see red squares where you clicked
7. Move the mouse to another spot and click again; do not drag the mouse to the new location
8. Click "OK" in the popup window when you are done drawing the path

### Changing the width and colors of PATHS

1. Right click on the PATH icon in the sidebar
2. Choose "Get Info"
3. Click on the "Style/Color" button
4. Make choices in this window
5. Click "OK" when done

### Changing PATHS in Google Earth

1. You can change or alter PATHS after you've drawn them
2. Click on the red dot in the PATH
3. It changes to green
4. Can drag to a different position
5. The blue dot is the last point of the PATH you worked on
6. The name of the PATH does not appear on the map; it only appears in the left sidebar
7. You can drag the paths to different positions in the sidebar. This does not alter its position on the map.
