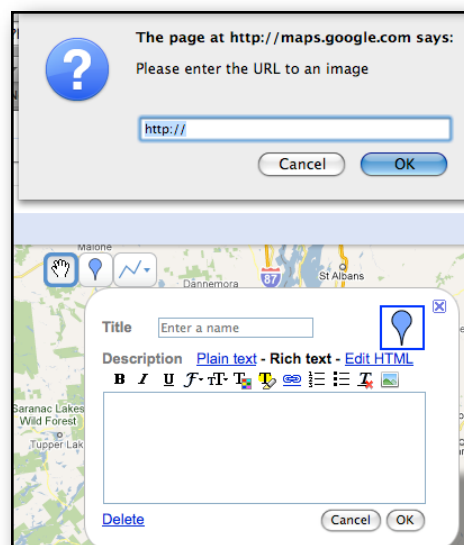

Finding An Image:

1. Work with the instructor to find an image on the WEB
2. At present, Google does not allow for uploading images from your hard drive to placemarkers
3. Learn to use different tabs or windows when finding images to make working easier
4. Copy the url for the image of your choice
5. Be sure you have located the image itself, not a page with several images and text

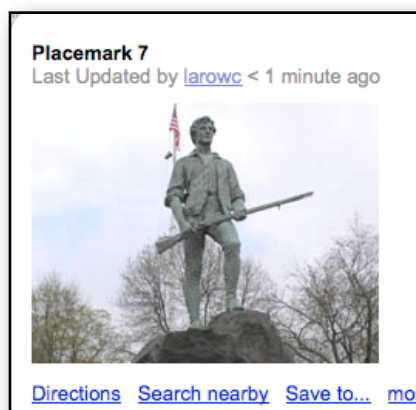
Adding Images To Placemarkers:

1. Add a placemaker to your map
2. Give the placemaker a title in the box provided
3. Click on the icon for inserting an image
4. A window will open above the window you are working on
5. Add the url for the image in the box provided. (The url is probably very long. Be sure and copy it from the site on the WEB.)
6. Note the site from which you obtain the image so you can cite your source.
7. Paste the url for the image into the box provided.

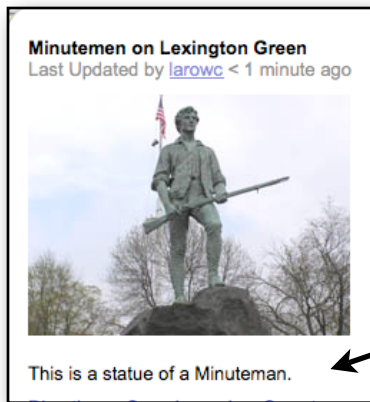

An image will appear inside the placemaker window:



1. Hit the Return Key to type text under the image, or
2. Add the text before you insert the image, if you wish to have the text above the image



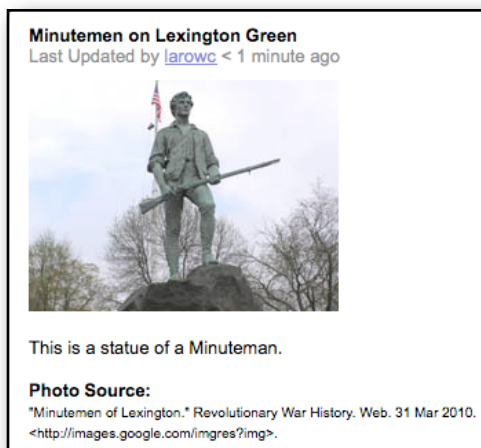

A good site for citing WEB images is “Son of Citation Machine.” <http://citationmachine.net/>

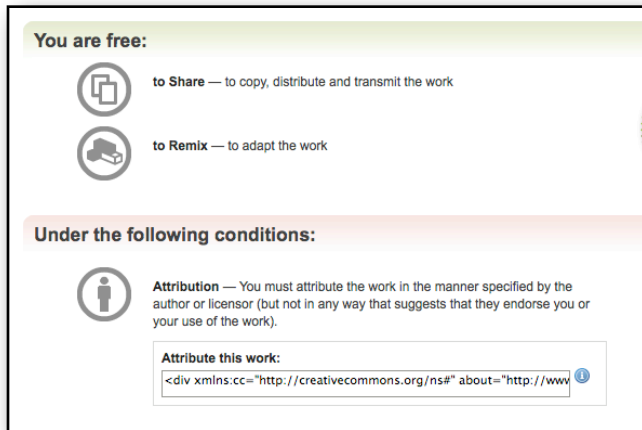

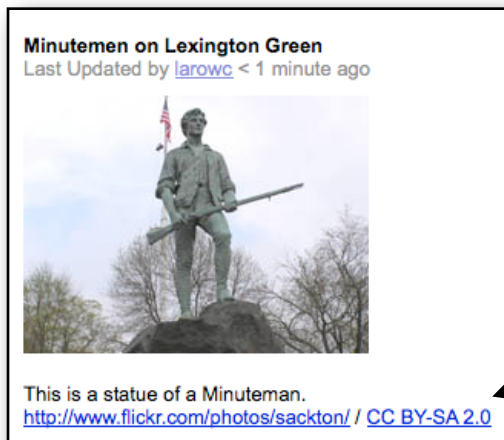
