1. You need "img src" if you want the image to show up in the popup window
2. To create a link to a photo on the WEB -> href
3. "href" - takes the user to the website for the photo
4. To use a photo on your hard drive, use the following. Type the "path" on your HD. Then, save the kml file so pictures stay with the Google Earth project.

5. It's easier to reference photos on the web. Sometimes, photos do not embed into the kml when you reference them on your hard drive.
